Minute 283 New Car Parking Regulations - Ditchling Village Hall Car Park Bee Lewis, LDC Contracts Manager – Leisure and Facilities had been invited by the Parish Council to talk about the proposals and to see if there was a way of resolving the issues which did not put anyone at a disadvantage. After some discussion it was agreed unanimously that the Council was opposed to any change and wanted the 72 hour restriction to remain.

A flyer had been produced from the South of Folders Lane Action Group re a proposed development at 60 Folders Lane comments were required by MSDC by 5th April –. 13/00784/FUL. It was noted that Councillor Tom Jones would represent the District and Parish Councils at the MSDC Planning Meeting in opposing the development.
