287. Minutes of the Council Meeting held on 27th March having been circulated, were taken as read, agreed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

288. LW/12/0290/NP South Street
Prior Approval Application - Installation of dark green DSLAM cabinet for Openreach
It was agreed to object to the proposed location of the cabinet. It would block an already narrow pavement – it was suggested that it would be better if sited by the current cabinet where the pavement is wider.

LW/12/0364/NP Court Cottage Lodge Hill Lane
Planning Application - Demolition of conservatory & construction of single storey extension with roof lantern & rooflights for Mr C Marshall
No objections.

3. LDC Letter re recycling cardboard etc. Copies of the letter had been circulated, it was agreed that the Village hall site should remain in its present form and that a more suitable site would premises in the Industrial Estate.

4. South Downs National Park - Vision consultation The Council considered the consultation document but would not be answering the questions individually. It felt that it was not a vision statement but a justification of the current position. It did not state the “vision” for the future or give any indication of the aims or aspirations as to how the South Downs National Park might evolve.
